## 4. SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

### SAFETY GUIDELINES

To achieve maximum safety while using your Razer Blue Screen, we suggest that you adopt the following guidelines:

- Should you have trouble operating the device correctly and troubleshooting does not work, contact the Razer hotline or go to [support.razer.com](https://support.razer.com) for support.
- Always position the screen on a flat and stable surface.
- When extending or retracting the screen, always use the carrying handle and practice caution to avoid injury.
- When extended, don't lean on or attach any items on (or on top of) the screen.
- When not in use and retracted, tuck each foot underneath the base and store the device horizontally.
- Don't expose the screen to direct sunlight for extended periods.
- Don't position and extend the screen in areas with strong air currents, as these may cause the screen to topple or affect the screen's appearance during use.
- When retracting the screen, make sure there are no obstructions on both ends and only push down from the carrying handle to avoid injury.

### MAINTENANCE AND USE

The Razer Blue Screen requires minimum maintenance to keep it in optimum condition. Once a month, we recommend you lightly wipe the screen using a soft cloth to prevent dirt buildup. Don't use soap or harsh cleaning agents.
