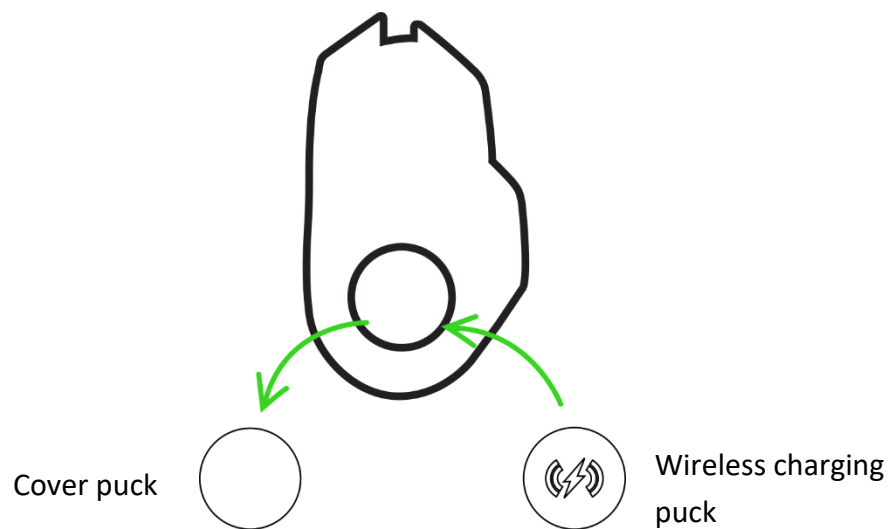


4. SETTING UP YOUR RAZER WIRELESS CHARGING PUCK

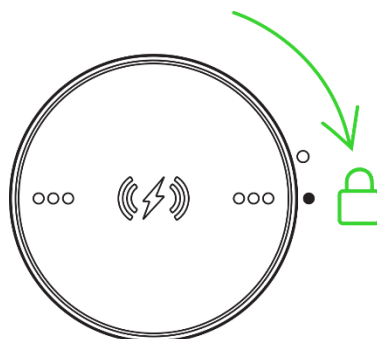
1. Unlock the cover puck.

SAFETY GUIDELINES
