This video is a step-by-step on how to activate the Razer Hypershift on a Razer mouse.

Razer Hypershift is a feature in Synapse that allows you to temporarily unlock a secondary set of functions on top of your existing button assignments, effectively doubling the number of customizable buttons on your device.

Let's get started.

First, open the Razer Synapse app, then select your mouse from the list of devices.

Next, assign a function to a button you prefer while in standard mode.

Check out the list of functions and controls you can program to your mouse in the description.

Click on the label below the mouse on the device layout to change it to "Hypershift." This will give you the device layout with a default setting.

Assign another function to the same button.

Click on the Hypershift label to change it back to standard mode.

Click on another button that you wish to assign the "HYPERSHIFT" modifier key.

Select the "HYPERSHIFT" option from the menu on the left side of the app window.

To complete the process, click "SAVE". The programmed button will appear in the device layout as "HYPERSHIFT".

To use Razer Hypershift, hold down the selected Hypershift modifier key and click on the button with a secondary function.
