This video provides a few ways to fix Razer keyboards with intermittent flickering or stuttering lighting effects.

This issue can be caused by connection, firmware, or software issues.

Fix flickering or stuttering lighting effects on your Razer keyboard by:

Connecting directly to your PC

Checking firmware updates

Resetting keyboard settings

Reinstalling Synapse

Connect your keyboard directly to your PC's USB port.

Using third-party USB hubs or extensions can lead to connection issues, which may cause stuttering or intermittent flickering.

It's also a good idea to check for any firmware updates.

Go to the link in the description to see if a firmware update is available for your device.

Download the firmware and follow the installation instructions provided.

Another way to fix intermittent flickering or stuttering lighting effects is to reset your keyboard's settings by exiting Synapse.

Go to the Razer icon on your taskbar and click "Exit Synapse."

If exiting Synapse solves the issue, it's possible that the lighting effects were incorrectly configured, or the profile itself was corrupted.

Perform a clean reinstall of Synapse.
