How to mix audio inputs in stream or recording using the Razer Ripsaw HD and OBS.

Let's get started.

Open OBS.

If you do not have the OBS installed on your device, check out the link in the description below on How to set up Razer Ripsaw HD with OBS.

Set up an audio input device such as microphone, console, capture card, and so on. Click on the + icon in the "Sources" box.

Select "Audio Input Capture", rename it if you want to, and then click "OK".

Select your device from the dropdown list then click "OK".

You should see the Audio Input Capture volume meter moving with the sound of your device.

Ensure that your device is not on mute.

Adjust the audio to your preference using the slider or fader.

You can also set values higher than the maximum, go to Edit Advanced Audio Properties and then adjust the volume value to your preference.

For further enhancements, you can make use of the filters. Click on the gear icon and click "filters."

Click on the "add" icon.

Select your preferred filter.

Rename it if you want to and then click "OK."

And that's it. You now have a better audio mix for your stream and recording.
