

How to optimize the battery life of your Razer Blade

This video will give you tips on how to optimize the battery life of your Razer Blade.

The battery performance of your Razer Blade primarily depends on your usage. However, the following tips can help extend the battery life of your Razer Blade.

Let's get started.

Decrease screen and keyboard brightness or you can opt to turn off your keyboard lighting.

To decrease screen brightness, press the Fn key + F8.

To decrease keyboard brightness, press Fn + F10.

Exit background applications that you are not currently using.

Set your Blade's Power mode to "Best power efficiency" or you can also enable "Battery saver" in the Power & battery settings.

Using the Power troubleshooter will help you conserve power and extend your battery life.

Go to Windows Settings > Troubleshoot.

After that, go to "Other troubleshooters".

Look for "Power", then click the "Run " button next to it.

Windows will then detect any issue with your Power settings and automatically correct them.

Change your System Performance Mode in Synapse

Go to Synapse > SYSTEM > PERFORMANCE.

Select your preferred mode under PERFORMANCE MODES > On Battery.

Reduce your screen refresh rate.

Go to Synapse > SYSTEM > PERFORMANCE.

Select the lowest rate under "SCREEN REFRESH RATE".

Change your GPU Mode in Synapse

Go to Synapse > SYSTEM > PERFORMANCE.

Select the appropriate GPU mode for your Razer Blade for better battery life and performance.

Choosing the wrong mode will cause the battery to drain.

Turn off your Razer Blade logo lighting.

Go to Synapse > System > Lighting.

Select "Off" under "SYSTEM LIGHTING" > On Battery > Logo.

Note: The availability of these options will depend on the model of your Razer Blade.

There you have it. You have now optimized the battery life of your Razer Blade.
