

How to pair the Razer HyperPolling Wireless Dongle and Razer Mouse Dock Pro with the Razer mouse

This video is a step-by-step process on how to pair the Razer HyperPolling Wireless Dongle and Razer Mouse Dock Pro with your Razer mouse.

Follow the link in the description to see if your device is listed among the compatible devices.

Let's get started.

Plug the Razer HyperPolling Wireless Dongle into the USB port of your PC.

After that, open Razer Synapse 3 and select the Razer HyperPolling Wireless Dongle from the list of devices.

Click "Open Pairing Utility" and connect a compatible device to the Razer HyperPolling Wireless Dongle.

Click on the "VIEW COMPATIBLE DEVICES" link below to see a list of compatible devices.

Set the compatible device switch to "2.4" GHz mode.

Note: Ensure that the device is not connected via USB and remove the device dongle if it is connected to the system.

Press and hold any key on the device until it is discoverable. Make sure the device is near the Hyperpolling dongle.

The pairing utility will show the devices found.

You have now successfully paired your device to the Razer HyperPolling Wireless dongle.

If you want to pair the Razer Mouse Dock Pro, follow these steps instead.

Connect the Razer Mouse Dock Pro to your PC and open Razer Synapse 3.

From the list of devices, select the Razer Mouse Dock Pro and click "Open Pairing Utility".

Connect a compatible device to the Razer Mouse Dock Pro and click "SELECT DEVICE".

If you want to see a list of compatible devices, click on the "VIEW COMPATIBLE MICE" link below

Set the compatible device switch to "2.4" GHz mode.

Press and hold any key on the device until it is found.

There you have it. You have now successfully paired your Razer HyperPolling Wireless Dongle and Razer Mouse Dock Pro.
