This video is a step-by-step process on how to remove and reattach ear cushions on a Razer headset.

Removing and reattaching the ear cushions on your headset should be done properly with utmost care to prevent any damage to its parts. Do note that cushions may vary according to the headset model.

To find a replacement for lost or damaged Razer parts, check out Where to buy Razer replacement parts and accessories (Razer Nari Dongles, Basilisk Clutch, and more) via the link in the description.

Let's get started.

For headsets with peel-off type ear cushions like some of the Razer Kraken and Nari series headsets, grab a portion near the outer lip of the cushion and cushion holder then gently pull until it pops off.

To reattach the ear cushion, put some of the cushion's outer lip onto the ear cushion holder and gently insert the rest of it into place. Make sure it is uniformly and smoothly attached.

For headsets with snap-type ear cushions like the Razer BlackShark V2 and Razer Opus, perform these steps:

First, pry open the first lower bottom joint using a flathead screwdriver.

Then pull up the cushion assembly at the leatherette region and detach each snap joint.

After detaching all snap joints, take out the cushion assembly.

To properly reattach the ear cushions, align the circular ribs to the guide bosses.

Then snap onto each corresponding interlocking holder by pressing on top of the leatherette. You should hear a clear clicking sound to ensure its proper attachment.

For headsets with rotating ear cushions like the Razer Kraken Pro V2, grab the ear cushion with your thumb and index finger then rotate the cushion counterclockwise to remove it.

To reattach the ear cushion, align the ear cushion onto the cushion holder then push and rotate in a clockwise motion to lock it in place.

Congratulations! You have successfully removed and reattached the ear cushions on your Razer headset.
